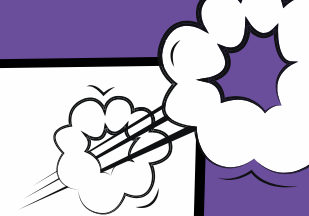


Write a three-digit number.

Your number

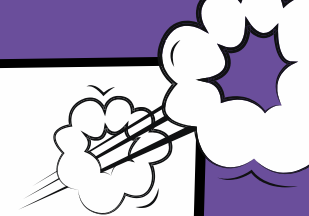
- has 5 in it

- is between 11 and 16 on a number path

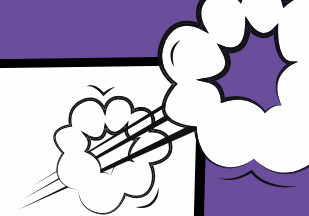


Choose a number from the hundred chart.

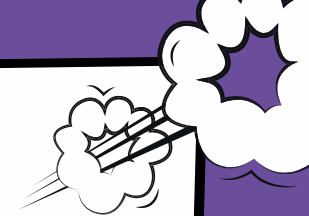


Write a basic addition fact.

- make ten and some more

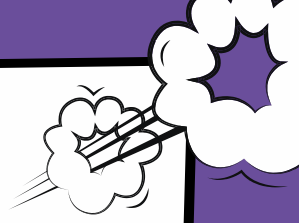


Write a three-digit number.

- is the smallest three-digit number in the class

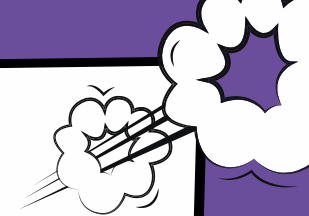


Write a fraction.

Your fraction

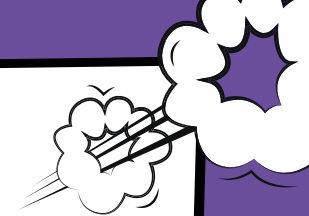
- is more than $\frac{1}{2}$

- has no tenths



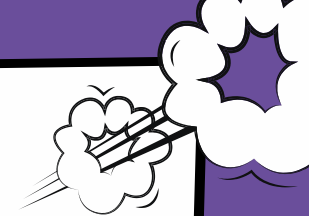
Write a number less than 100.
