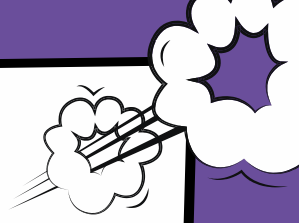


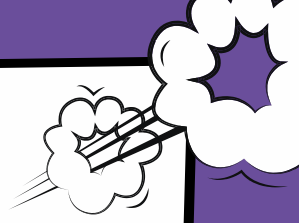
The Mystery Number

- is less than 50
- is greater than 18
- is made with a 3
- is not made with a 4
- is between 20 and 30



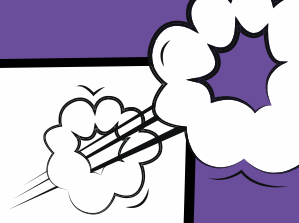
The Mystery Number

- is made with one ten frame
- is more than 5
- is not one more than 6
- is not one less than 8
- is one less than 10



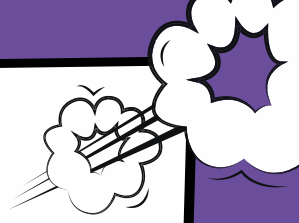
The Mystery Number

- is between 50 and 80
- is not 10 more than 63
- has 11 as the sum of its digits
- has 7 tens



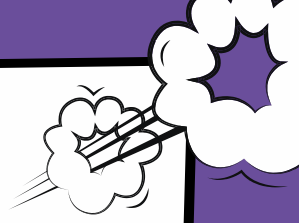
The Mystery Number

- is said when skip-counting
- has a 5 in it
- is less than 80
- has digits that are a sum of 10
- is halfway between 50 and 60



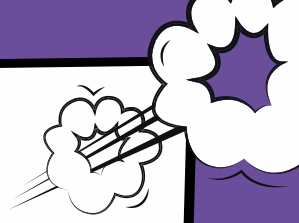
The Mystery Number

- is even
- is more than $9 + 9$
- has a 2 in it
- is less than 40



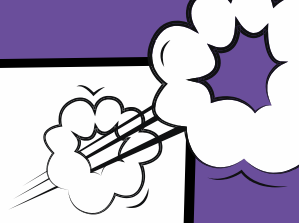
The Mystery Number

- is more than 300
- has one 7 and one 6 in it
- rounds to 400
- rounds to 380



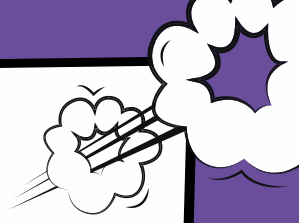
The Mystery Number

- is less than half of 8,000
- is more than 2,000
- has two 3s
- has two 4s
- is odd



The Mystery Fact

- is a two-more fact
- is a two-digit sum
- is made with two even addends
- is a make-ten fact



The Mystery Fact

- has an odd product
- is product between 25 and 40
- is related to a $\times 10$ fact
- has a product in the 30s
